Participation Club Responsibility

- Each club is required to pay **S\$80** to the ICPL Treasurer no later than **one week** before the league starts.
- Convenor/Captain will then collect fees for the remaining four round-robin from the players (S\$80/RR) or from their group funds. These funds will be used to cover the hosting refreshment.
- Hosting:
 - Event Coordination: Schedule and Organizing hosting round.
 - Sponsor Engagement: **Providing booth or table space (e.g 1 x1.6m) for sponsors** to display products and promotional materials.
 - Hospitality: Providing drinks and refreshments throughout the hosting session.



Participating Players

- Each Club is allow to register **Unlimited** players.
 - Point to take note: **Not all** registered players will receive the event items (e.g Paticipation gifts if issue) and award if the team is winning.
 - DUPR ratings and age are fixed at time of registration.
- Lineup submission: Club must submit **2 hours** before start of the round.
- Indemnity Form: All Players **must sign** the indemnity form that is provided on the Padlet app.
- Repeat Lady Player : Per round, a maximum of two ladies player are allowed. **One female player** may repeat once **in Advanced** and **one female player** may repeat once **in Intermediate**.
- Reporting time: Players must report **15mins** before the match commenced.



Game Format

- Match Structure: Each Match consists of two (2) Games played to 21 points. There is no "deuce"; games end with sudden death when a team reaches 21 points.

Points System



- Points allocation:
 - Match Win: 3 points
 - Match Draw: 2 points
 - Match Loss: 1 point

 - Tie Win: 2 points
 - Tie Draw: 1 point
 - Tie loss: 0 point
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- GND Fairness Adjustments applied where there is a gender discrepancy:
 - MD vs XD: XD starts with a 3-point advantage.
 - MD vs WD: WD starts with a 5-point advantage.
 - XD vs WD: WD starts with a 3-point advantage.

Others

- Injury Potocol: If a player is injured during a rally, play continues to conclusion of the rally. If the player cannot continue after a 10-minute medical time-out (or extended period approved by organisers), the team may either:
 - (a) forfeit that Game; or
 - (b) elect to continue the Game and Match with the one remaining player.
- Rain Before a Match Starts: If it is raining and the captains have not agreed to postpone, all players must attend the venue. A match can only commence if both captains agree. If the match cannot start within 30 minutes of the scheduled time, it will be postponed.
